

Jelly Roll Quilt

Size 50" x 66"

Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Requirements

FJ-1/5 turquoise and blue– Noodles Jelly Roll

Fabric 1.

F9004 col.7 green and blue - 60cm.

Wadding and Backing 54" x 70"

Thread;

Aurifil Mako 2715 – light blue

Take out 5 Strips of fabric and lay them aside to use later on as binding, this will not be enough to go the entire way around the quilt, but you will end up with pieces left over to make up the length.

Cutting

From Fabric 1.

12 x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares – cut in half diagonally once

1 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares - cut in half diagonally twice

Making

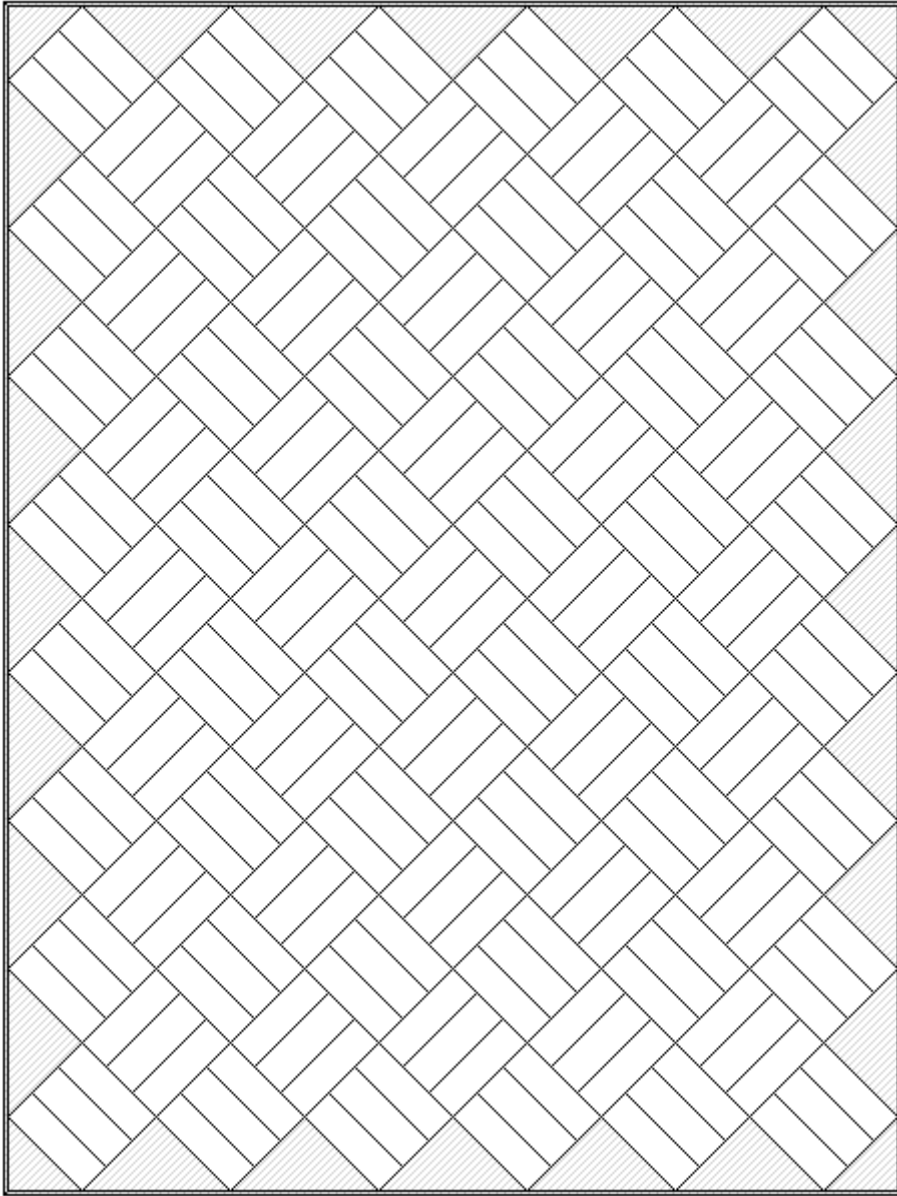
Join your strips together in groups of 3 to make a wider strip. Do not worry too much about trying to match up colours, you get the best results if you pick out the strips at random.

Once you have joined all of your strips together, cut them at $6\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals to make squares. You will need to cut 83 squares in total to use for the quilt.

Refer to the main diagram and lay out all of your fabric pieces, laying your triangles of fabric 1 around the edge.

Join all of the pieces together. Start by making diagonal rows and then join these rows together to form the top layer of the quilt. Sandwich together the top layer, wadding and backing, and quilt.

Make up binding, using the strips that you set aside earlier and also using some of the left over fabric pieces to make up the length. Add the binding to complete the quilt.



Main diagram
